## ADDITIONAL FILM PROGRAMMING: SHORT FILMS, VR & SPECIAL SCREENING OF BALLET NOW

**New York, NY (May 22, 2018)** – The Nantucket Film Festival (NFF) announced today additional programming for the 2018 line-up and talent attending the Festival, including co-hosts and presenters for the 2018 Screenwriters Tribute. The 23rd annual Nantucket Film Festival runs June 20-25, 2018.

Actor, writer, director and producer **Ben Stiller** (THE MEYEROWITZ STORIES (NEW AND SELECTED), TROPIC THUNDER, MEET THE PARENTS) and actor/comedian **Mike Birbiglia** (DON'T THINK TWICE, TRAINWRECK) will co-host the **2018 Screenwriters Tribute** on Saturday, June 23, 2018. Actor **Adam Driver** (STAR WARS: THE LAST JEDI, Jim Jarmusch's PATERSON, Spike Lee's BLACKKKLANSMAN) will present the previously announced Screenwriters Tribute Award to Oscar®-nominated writer/director **Noah Baumbach**. Driver has appeared in Baumbach's THE MEYEROWITZ STORIES (NEW AND SELECTED), WHILE WE'RE YOUNG and FRANCES HA, and recently completed shooting Baumbach's latest feature opposite Scarlett Johansson. Actor **Garrett Hedlund** (MUDBOUND, BILLY LYNN'S LONG HALFTIME WALK) will present **Andrew Heckler** with the New Voices in Screenwriting Award. Hedlund stars alongside Forest Whitaker and Andrea Riseborough in Heckler's Sundance Audience Award-winner BURDEN, which will screen at the Festival.

Returning programs at this year's Festival include **In Their Shoes...**<sup>®</sup>, a conversation between MSNBC's Chris Matthews and Noah Baumbach, Adam Driver, and Ben Stiller; as well as the daily **Morning Coffee With...**<sup>®</sup>, sponsored by *The Inquirer & Mirror*, a daily kick-off discussion between attending writers, directors, and new host Tom Cavanagh (*The Flash, Ed*).

Also returning is **Women Behind the Words**, sponsored by Lifetime, which had its inaugural event in 2015, focused on gender inequality in the entertainment industry. Following a year of new conversations and developments in the wake of #MeToo and the Time's Up movements, NPR's *Ask Me Another* host **Ophira Eisenberg** will moderate a conversation to discuss what comes next. Guests include actresses **Jeanne Tripplehorn** (*Big Love*, WE ONLY KNOW SO MUCH) and **Alysia Reiner** (*Orange Is the New Black*, EGG), television writer/producer **Sera Gamble** (Lifetime's upcoming *You*, *The Magicians*), and actress, director, and producer **Miranda Bailey** (SWISS ARMY MAN, YOU CAN CHOOSE YOUR FAMILY).

Additional film programming announced as part of the 2018 Festival includes a special screening of documentary feature **BALLET NOW**, directed by Steven Cantor, and executive produced by Paul G. Allen's Vulcan Productions and actress Elisabeth Moss, on the final day of the Festival, Monday, June 25. Cantor will also be present for a post-screening conversation.

This intimate documentary provides a candid behind-the-scenes look at the world of ballet, following New York City Ballet's Prima Ballerina Tiler Peck, the first woman to curate the Music Center's famed Ballet*NOW*, as she attempts a fresh new approach by merging the worlds of ballet, tap, and hip-hop together through a groundbreaking one-of-a-kind performance. Throughout the film, as Tiler faces the demands of an incredibly challenging production, she is driven to show young people the beauty, possibilities and freedom of dance and expression. Executive Producer, Paul G. Allen has always had a passion and commitment for the classical arts, and hopes that showcasing the ballet world and the arts as a whole will continue to inspire and engage younger audiences, while affecting enthusiasts.

Also revealed were six **Short Film Programs**, including Miguel Alvarez's ATLANTIC CITY featuring Raúl Castillo, Ross Kauffman's BOY BOY GIRL GIRL featuring Katie Holmes, Pete Lee's DON'T BE A HERO featuring Missy Pyle, and Tom Cavanagh's TOM AND GRANT featuring Cavanagh and Grant Gustin, his co-star from *The Flash*; as well as a new program putting the spotlight on some of the year's most-honored shorts.

Finally, the third edition of **Enter the Story: Virtual Reality Experiences** has been unveiled, including MY AFRICA, narrated by Academy Award winner Lupita Nyong'o; TAKE EVERY WAVE: LAIRD IN VR featuring Laird Hamilton; and immersive titles straight from the VR arcades at SXSW and Tribeca: DINNER PARTY, FIRE ESCAPE, and MY JOURNEY.

Miranda Bailey is a producer, actor, and director. Among the Ims she has produced are the Oscar®-nominated THE SQUID AND THE WHALE, the Spirit Award-winning THE DIARY OF A TEENAGER GIRL, and SWISS ARMY MAN. Bailey's directorial narrative feature debut, YOU CAN CHOOSE YOUR FAMILY, premiered at SXSW and screens at NFF this year. She previously directed the documentary features GREENLIT and THE PATHOLOGICAL OPTIMIST. Bailey recently launched CherryPicks, a film site consisting of reviews by female critics, countering the inherent male bias on other sites.

Dade Hayes is a New York-based contributing editor at *Deadline Hollywood*. He has held senior editor positions at *Variety* and *Entertainment Weekly* and has written for *The New York Times*, *The Los Angeles Times*, and *TV Guide*, among other publications. Hayes is the author of two books, *Anytime Playdate: Inside the Preschool Entertainment Boom, Or, How Television Became My Baby's Best Friend*, and *Open Wide: How Hollywood Box Office Became a National Obsession*.

Janet Pierson is the director of film at SXSW, responsible for the vision, programming, and

execution of the SXSW Film Festival. Before joining SXSW in 2009, Pierson spent over 30 years championing independent films and filmmakers in a variety of roles, including exhibitor, producer's rep, executive producer, segment director of the IFC cable TV series *Split Screen*, and as a subject in the Steve James documentary REEL PARADISE.

Paul Eckstein is the creator and executive producer of the upcoming Disney/Epix drama *Godfather* of *Harlem* starring Forest Whitaker. He wrote and produced the first year of Netflix's *Narcos* and ABC's *Of Kings and Prophets*. Eckstein started out with the Naked Angels theater company, where he produced *Naked Rights* and *Gunplay*, among others.

Sera Gamble is a showrunner, writer, and producer. Currently, she is the writer and executive producer of *The Magicians* (SyFy), which she co-created with John McNamara, and co-creator and writer of *You* (Lifetime). Previously she was a writer and producer for *Aquarius* (NBC) and *Supernatural* (CW).

Lydia Cavallo Zasa is executive director of Screenwriters Colony, an organization dedicated to increasing the number of groundbreaking stories in popular culture by discovering emerging writers with singular voices and supporting them with nurturing residency and mentorship programs. Previously Lydia ran the Columbia University Film Festival for over a decade and started the school's ScriptConnect program linking graduating writers with the film industry.
